A Philosophy of a Family-Focused Youth Ministry "Exists To Assist"

Purpose: Family focused youth ministry exists to help youth and their families succeed at being growing, healthy disciples of Christ.

Goals:

- 1. To intentionally support parents in their role as primary disciplemakers in their homes. Deuteronomy 6, Deuteronomy 29:29, Psalm 78, Proverbs, Ephesians 6:1-4. How this will be accomplished:
 - a. We will do this by keeping parents informed of what is going on and why.
 - b. We will do this by assisting them with the resources and training to be effective in bringing up their children in the fear and admonition of the Lord.
 - c. We will do this by encouraging them to be involved in the lives of their kids and other youth.
 - d. We will do this by taking every opportunity to support parents by standing with them and behind them with the goal of making them successful.
 - e. We will do this by not substituting nor assuming the role of parents in the lives of the youth.
 - f. We will do this by inviting their input and wisdom in overall ministry goals.
- 2. To provide students with opportunities to know Christ, to become like Christ, and to make Christ known to both their peers and others. Colossians 1:28.

How this will be accomplished:

- a. We will do this by reaching non-believing students with the life-changing message of the Gospel.
- b. We will do this by building them up in their faith.
- c. We will do this by equipping them to do the work of ministry.
- d. We will do this by using youth's natural and inevitable attraction to peers for evangelistic and discipleship opportunities.
- 3. To assist the church family in promoting healthy Biblical community, Ephesians 4:12-16. How this will be accomplished:
 - a. We will do this by intentionally involving youth in the total life of the church.
 - b. We will do this by promoting partnership opportunities between youth and adults.
 - c. We will do this by considering family times and other church activities when scheduling youth events.

Values/Beliefs of Family-Focused Youth Ministry:

- 1. The Bible is our final source for all matters of faith and practice.
- 2. The Family Focused Youth Pastor is a shepherd who guides and assists parents without replacing them.
- 3. Truth is shared in the context of a love relationship.
- 4. The process of how we do ministry is as important as the result we are trying to achieve.
- 5. Ministry is best accomplished together in community.
